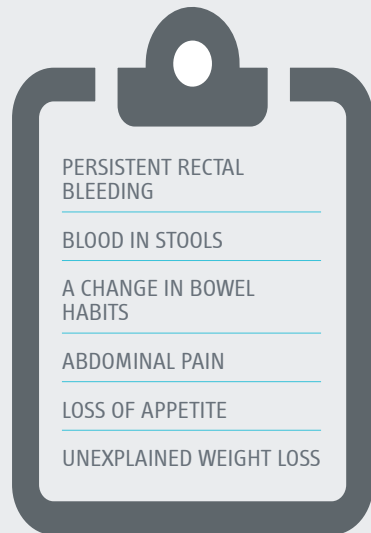


COLORECTAL CANCER

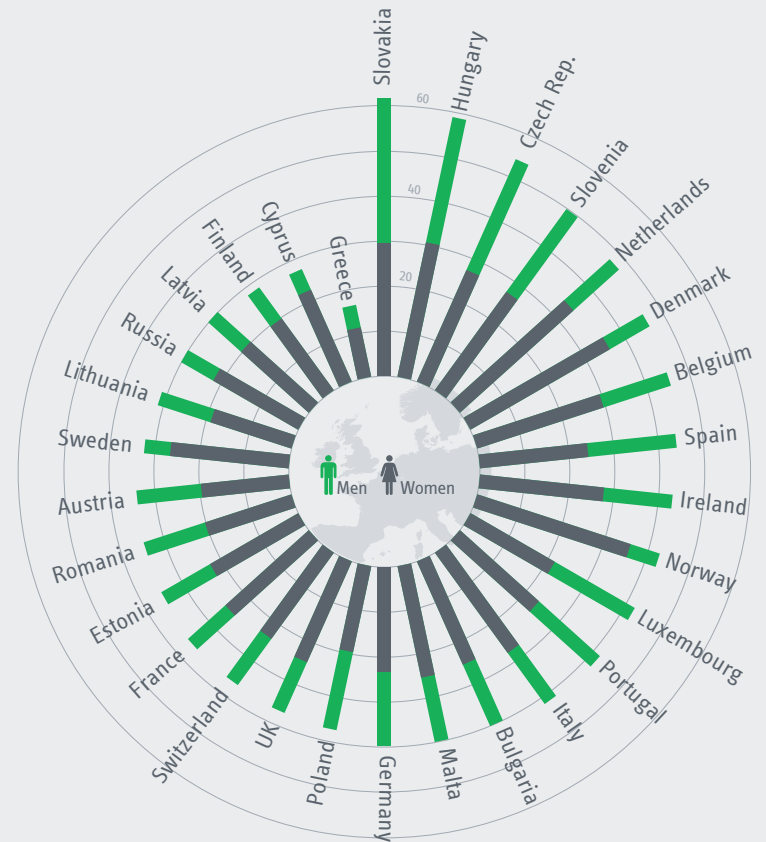
Colorectal cancer (CRC) is the second most common cancer in Europe, accounting for over 14% of all cancer diagnoses across the continent. One European dies every 3 minutes from CRC.
